## SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

Vessel was beached after collision near Cape Stora, Sea of Marmora, on 20<sup>th</sup> May. She was refloated on 31<sup>st</sup> May & towed to Constantinople.

A report published in *Times* stated that a salvage steamer left Trieste for Constantinople on 10<sup>th</sup> June in order to tow the vessel to Genoa for repairs. The salvage steamer was taking the necessary materials for effecting temporary repairs.

A report was subsequently received from the Constantinople Surveyor stating that damage had been sustained by the vessel to the bridge side plating, together with the sheerstrake plating & the plating below same, also to the stringer plate & deck plates etc. The Surveyor recommended that the class of the vessel be suspended until the necessary repairs were effected, unless temporary repairs were carried out before the vessel left his port.

On 24<sup>th</sup> June the Committee decided to defer the case for repairs.

On 27<sup>th</sup> June the Constantinople Surveyor cabled that the vessel was being temporarily repaired, but not under his supervision.

The following cable was accordingly sent to the owner:-  
 "Srig please arrange temporary repairs be inspected by  
 Soviet's Surveyor Constantinople to retain class"

A reply has been received from the owner to this cablegram.

A further telegram dated 28<sup>th</sup> June has been received from the Constantinople Surveyor stating that the vessel has left his port without survey.

In these circumstances it is thought well to again submit the case for the Committee's consideration.
