SRGJ (s).—Trieste, June 10.—The salvage steamer Cyclops left to-day for Constantinople in order to tow the Austrian steamer Srgj to Genoa, where she will dry dock to repair the damage sustained by collision with the French steamer Niger. The Cyclops is taking the necessary materials for effecting temporary repairs.

rs of Casualty

Vessel was beached after collision near the Hora, Sea of Marmora, on 20th May.

She was refloated on the 31st May & towed Constantinople where she arrived on 6th June.

On 3rd June the Owners wrote that one of their directors was proceeding to Constantinople in order to see whether the vessel could be repaired & if so to what port she had better proceed.

On 10th June the Committee decided to defer the case for a month.

A letter since received from the Constantinople Surveyor states:-

"I am going tomorrow (7/6/10) to hold a survey for the Austrian Consul and will report fully later. I understand she is very badly damaged in starboard bunker, being run into almost to the keel plate. Will probably be temporarily repaired & take her to Trieste"

A report published in Lloyd's

of 13th June states that a salvage steamer left Trieste for Constantinople on 10th June in order to tow the vessel to Genoa where she will be dry docked for repairs. The salvage steamer is taking the necessary materials for effecting temporary repairs.
