Bosphorus. I have
just seen ^{tomorrow} who had
a survey for the
Austrian Consul.
The vessel is in
very poor
condition. The
hull is very badly
damaged in the
hull being run
into almost to the
keel plate. will pro-
bably be temporary
repairs to take her
to Trieste.
