

tion.

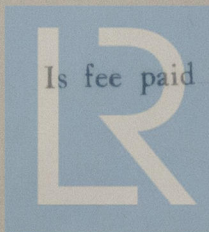
