dock.

Nothing was done for nearly a month  
when Steamer and cargo was sold to  
Salvors.

Wood cargo in Nos 1 & 2 Holds has  
been discharged.

The recommended temporary repairs  
mostly cementing are in hand in Fore  
Peak and Nos 1 & 2 Holds.

The steamer may reload cargo for  
Alexandria and proceed to Genoa to be  
broken up but arrangements at present  
are unknown.
