This vessel was beached after striking a submerged object when entering Bender Eregli on the 25th November, 1936.

The Owners subsequently stated that the Underwriters had accepted the vessel as a Constructive Total Loss, & the Committee decided to expunge her class & insert a record of "Wrecked 11.36" against her name in the Register Book.

The vessel was refloated on the 4th February, 1937, & arrived at Istanbul under her own power. The record of "Wrecked 11.36" was accordingly altered to "Stranded 11.36 - Refloated".

The vessel has been purchased by the Tank Coasters (Le Progrès) Ltd. of London, renamed "Eregli" & is now trading.

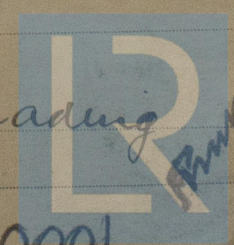
No request for survey with a view to reclassification with this Society has been received.
