Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your telegram relative to the steamer "PENNSYLVANIE" as follows:-

"PENNSYLVANIE 82923 IN REGISTER PLEASE FORWARD
"PARTICULARS MEASUREMENTS INTERNATIONAL FREEBOARD
"ASSIGNMENT ALSO REPORT C. ELEVEN VESSEL BEING
"CONVERTED TO OPEN SHELTER DECK".

I enclose an extract of particulars taken from the previous freeboard report on the ship and have to inform you that she has not yet been surveyed for the assignment of Convention freeboards. You should forward full particulars on Report C.11 for assignment as an open shelter decker, and I have to remind you that any scuppers led from the shelter tween decks to the bilges (other than the machinery space bilges) should be permanently closed by riveted plates. In your report you should indicate the exact position of the tonnage opening and of the bulkheads at the forward and after ends of the tonnage well, giving full particulars of the hatchways on both the shelter deck and upper (i.e. freeboard) deck.
