Sirs,

I have to acknowledge the telegram which has been
received from you to-day as follows, namely,

"Steamer Cardigan here for alteration opening shelter
deck and reverting to original freeboard please
forward plans and any particulars",

With regard thereto I enclose for your information and
reference the midship section and profile plans of the vessel,
together with particulars of the amended freeboard assignment,
subject to a tonnage opening being made in the shelter deck,
as proposed by the Owners under the conditions named thereon
including the fitting of efficient temporary closing
devices over the tonnage opening, in accordance with the
rules for shelter deck vessels; bulkheads being fitted
across the upper and shelter decks at each end of the tonnage
opening, and the scuppers from the upper deck to the
lower deck being closed with riveted plates.

You should report regarding these alterations in
accordance with the back of form 11b.


