Yours of the 16th inst. received relative to

The transverse frames and beams in way of the after
peak are as approved. The butts of shell plating in way of
ridge side and butts of sheerstrake and strake below clear
of the bridge is as required.

The hold transverse lugs to shell are double throughout
or three spaces above tank top.

S. I understand this vessel is now repairing at Newport News
having lost her rudder and broken the sternframe. This
probably happened in Jax where the vessel was aground on
several occasions and loaded on the bottom.
