Dear Madam,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the steamer "CRISTOBAL COLON" I think it well to acquaint you that from reports received in this Office it appears that this vessel ran ashore in Bermuda on the 25th October last, whereby it is believed her back is broken. No further information has been received and in all the circumstances, the Committee, who have had the case before them, have decided to make a record of "Stranded 10,36" against the vessel's name in the Society's Register Book and to expunge her class in accordance with the usual practice.

I shall therefore be glad if you will kindly inform the Owners accordingly and at the same time endeavour to ascertain from them and let me know the exact position regarding the vessel and what it is proposed to do with her.
