I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your classing letter of the 18th. instant on the 1st. Entry report No. 1019 on the Spanish steamer "CRISTOBAL COLON" together with the classing certificates on the hull and machinery and I desire to thank you for their early delivery.

In connexion with your remarks I beg to submit the following .  
The Panting arrangements are as the approved plan and list of equivalent sections . (The approved plan is enclosed herewith)  
The spacing of the rivets in the treble riveted butts of the shell plating , the double riveted butts of the forecastle side plating , the thickness of the mast plating at heel, and the reverse bars on bulkheads 194, 172, & 154 are as approved and not as given in my report.

The stream steel wire is as approved on the midship section i.e. 105 fathoms steel wire rope of 5 1/4" (five and a quarter) circ. and was made by the Warrington Wire Rope Co. .

The only forging reports in this office are the enclosed viz.  
Rudder frame , tiller and quadrant.
