In connexion with the enclosed 1st Entry report on the Spanish steamer "CRISTOBAL COLON", built at Ferrol, I beg to make the following observations. The vessel is stated to have been placed in dry dock on two occasions since being launched, the last occasion being about three weeks ago, but was not seen by a Surveyor to this Society.

The registered depth and the signal letters are not yet available. A Midship Section (translated) of the vessel as built has been forwarded by separate post and it should be noted that the sectional material is to the equivalent sizes as rolled in Spain.


As this vessel is now at this port awaiting steam trials and as the Classification Certificates require to be presented to the Spanish Government at the Government trial which is to take place shortly, the favor of their early delivery duly vised is solicited.
