With further reference to my confidential letter of the 25th October last in connection with the freeboard of the above mentioned vessel I am privately informed today by the Compañía Trasatlantica that the question of the difference of freeboard between the two sister ships "HABANA" and "CRISTOBAL COLON", the latter freeboard being assigned by the Government inspector at this port, is to be raised officially almost immediately a protest to be forwarded simultaneously to Lloyd's Register of Shipping London and to the Marine Dept. Madrid.
