Dear Sirs,

With reference to your freeboard report on the S.S. "CRISTOBAL COLON", I enclose herewith the usual printed letters/giving particulars of the freeboards which have been assigned to this vessel.

With regard to this case I have to inform you that there does not appear to be any protection provided to the stairways through the upper deck in way of the open wells forward and aft, and any water which may enter through the openings in the vessel's sides would flow into the tween deck spaces below. The stairways should therefore be enclosed in substantial casings having hinged doors, and particulars of these casings should be submitted for approval.

The plan and book of plans forwarded to this Office for/dealing with the case are returned herewith.
