

As you are aware this vessel is being built in Spain and it is intended that she should comply with the requirements of the British Board of Trade for passenger steamers, and also with the requirements of the International Convention.

As the vessel is being built in Spain the Board of Trade are not able to issue a passenger certificate, but it has been arranged that we submit to them ^(The P.O.T.) the plans of the vessel and if satisfactory they will issue a letter saying, if the vessel had been built in this country and the materials had been tested according to their requirements, that the vessel would have been entitled to a British Board of Trade Passenger Certificate.

We have received through your local surveyor a copy of Circular 1285, which refers to submission to you of plans
