Dear Sirs,

With reference to Mr. Sneddon's letter of the 21st instant enclosing a request form, together with particulars for the assignment of freeboard to Messrs. Swan, Hunter & Wigham Richardson's S.S.No.1010, I have to inform you that with the position of the sill of the lowest sidelight given by the Builders, viz., 10 feet below the wood upper deck at side the freeboard for all Seasons would be  $10'-7\frac{1}{2}"$  from statutory deck line  $1\frac{1}{2}"$  above the wood upper deck at side.

As regards the Builders' request for the freeboards required for the vessel without the sidelights below the main deck, I shall be glad if you will be good enough to forward a small outline profile sketch showing in figured dimensions the position and extent of the openings in the shade deck sides, and of the enclosed portions between the upper and shade decks.
