
Dear Mr. Sladden:

I am in receipt of your letter of the 4th instant enclosing copy of a letter received from the Solicitors to the Owners of the Steamer "QUARRINGTON COURT", which was lost in December, 1937 and, having talked the matter over with Mr. Heck, it appears that he has already discussed this subject to some extent with the Isthmian Line (the Charterers) in conjunction with the Owners and, as the points in question are essentially engineering features, dealing with Survey procedure and Certificates, it has been arranged that Mr. Heck will give evidence, on questions of fact or procedure, at the proceedings which are pending in New York in this case.
