

In connexion with the attached endorsement I telephoned Mr. Chambers, Secretary of Messrs. McIvor & Kauffman any information in strict accordance with his personal knowledge.

He added that it was probable an American Lawyer would be attending the Board of Trade enquiry at Newcastle on the 27th instant, so that it might be possible for him to take any evidence in this country concerning the classification requirements of this Society.
