Dear Mr. Scott,

I am enclosing herewith my report on the Enquiry into the loss of the "QUARRINGTON COURT", and am returning also the copies of reports which were used by me at the Enquiry. The originals are all in the London Office.

I am also enclosing a statement of my expenses all of which are chargeable to the Board of Trade. I have instructed Mr. Matthews, who was at the Court for two days, to forward a statement of expenses for two days at £3.3.0 per day, and this is also chargeable to the Board of Trade.


