

Dear Mr. Scott,

I am enclosing herewith my report on the Enquiry into the loss of the "QUARRINGTON COURT", and am returning also the copies of reports which were used by me at the Enquiry. The originals are all in the London Office.

I am also enclosing a statement of my expenses all of which are chargeable to the Board of Trade. I have instructed Mr. Matthews, who was at the Court for two days, to forward a statement of expenses for two days at £3.3.0 per day, and this is also chargeable to the Board of Trade.

Owing to large scale evacuation of people in the vicinity of my home my people came to Newcastle on Wednesday. I shall, therefore, be remaining here for a few days, but in view of this morning's news we shall be returning to London next week.
