*I beg to inform you that the main & donkey boiler safety valves of the new steamer "Colusa" were adjusted under steam on March 28th & that the thickness of the adjusting washers is as follows:—
Port M.B. P $\frac{7}{16}$ " S $\frac{1}{32}$ ", Centre M.B. P $\frac{7}{16}$ " S $\frac{1}{32}$ ",
Starb. M.B. P $\frac{1}{32}$ " S $\frac{9}{32}$ ". Donkey Boiler, A $\frac{3}{8}$ " F $\frac{3}{8}$ ".*

The Official Steam Trial was satisfactorily carried out in my presence on April 2nd 1913 & the Machinery Certificate & Certificates of Test of main & donkey boilers were handed to Mess^{rs} David Rowan & Co. representative at the conclusion.
