Nature of Survey.....

The Curacao Surveyor reports this vessel placed in dry dock, the bottom found generally in good condition and recoated.

On account of corrosion the stern plating has been repaired by electric welding and protection plates fitted over same and to rudder mainpiece. ✶ ARMS.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 9,29, as recommended.
