Remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The Newcastle Surveyors report the ship placed in dry dock, bottom cleaned and coated and minor repairs effected.

A 'Gyro' compass has been fitted, alterations effected to the poop front bulkhead made intact, skylights fitted on the poop deck, oertz rudder dispensed with and a new rudder fitted in accordance with approved plans etc., alterations effected to the steering gear and the poop deck in way stiffened.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 6,37.
