I return herewith one copy of each of the forwarded by you to Mr. Dykes with your letter of the instant of the oil fuel bunkers and settling tanks for the S.S. "WESTMINSTER ABBEY", and with regard I have to state that provided the arrangements be put out as shown and amended on the plans, and to your action, the same will be approved.

The flash point of the oil fuel to be should be above 150°F., and the remaining requirements of section 49 of the Rules should be complied with where applicable.

You should satisfy yourself as to the condition of the existing structure forming the boundaries of the tanks.

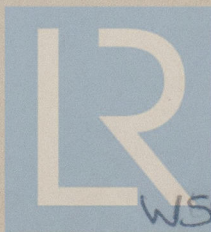
One copy of each of the plans is being kept in this Office for record, and the approved plans of plan section and profile forwarded for reference are also kept.
