For your information and guidance I enclose herewith a copy of a letter which has today been addressed to the Owners on the subject.

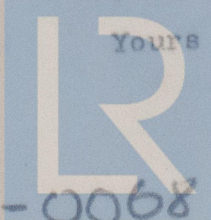
The plan sent by you for reference is also enclosed.
