Our Superintendent Mr. Brewer, visited the s.s. "Minster Abbey" under repairs at Bremerhaven, in company with your Surveyor, and found the lining cut away from the bottom of the ship in a number of places for examination of the inside shell plating in way of the passenger accommodation. The plating was found in very good condition, and the original lining still intact. Your surveyor was unwilling to strip the lining further, but suggested that it was a matter for the owners to put forward for consideration. We shall therefore be much obliged if you will kindly advise the local surveyors that this matter will be in order.

Whilst in Germany our Mr. Brewer also visited Mr. Dykes at Hamburg, who concurred in the above recommendation.
