I beg to forward herewith under separate cover a plan in duplicate shewing the steam superheating arrangement proposed to be fitted by Messrs. J. C. Tecklenberg of Geestemünde in the steamer "WESTMINSTER ABBEY" ex "ADOLF WOERMANN" No. 50215 in the Register book now being under survey at Bremerhaven with a view to the completion of her class in the Society's Register book (see previous correspondence concerning this vessel) and with regard thereto I beg to remark, that it is submitted by the manufacturers to use in the construction of the arrangement materials which they have on stock and of which the cast steel collectors have been made by Messrs. G & J. Jäger of Elberfeld and tested by the Surveyors to the Germ. Lloyd as per certificate attached, whereas the elements have been manufactured by Messrs. the A. G. Lauchhammer of Lauchhammer and are stated to have been tested by this firm by an hydraulic pressure of 100 kilogrammes per square centimetre.

I shall feel obliged for being informed if and under which conditions these materials could be accepted.
