for further examination. On Wednesday the 6th July 1921 examined
vessel's bottom in the Kaiserdock at Bremerhaven, and found
on port side in way of after end of No. 2 hold the bilge keel
& connecting T iron bar were badly indented and broken for
length of about twenty feet.

It was recommended that the damaged bilge keel and connecting
be renewed and that any cement found broken in way of the
be renewed.
