Dear Sirs,

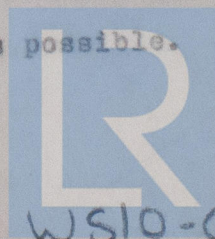
I have to acquaint you that the Ministry of Shipping state that the ex-German Steamers "ADOLPH WERMANN" and "TANNENBERG" are being purchased by Messrs. The David S.S. Co., (Brokers Messrs. D. G. Mackay & Co. Ltd.), and as these vessels are now in the hands of the new Owners, it is probable that Mr. Brewer, the new Owners' Superintendent may call upon you relative to the vessels' classification.

I enclose herewith copies of the previous condition survey reports on the "ADOLPH WERMANN", together with the First Entry reports and approved plans of the "TANNENBERG", and you will observe from the attached correspondence in this case that a Special Survey No. 1 is required to render the vessel eligible for classification.

I have therefore to request that you will ascertain if possible the new Owners' intention as regards classification in both these cases, and let me know the result as soon as possible.
