Dear Sirs,

With regard to your freeboard report on the S.S. "ADOLPH WOERMANN", I enclose herewith a printed letter of assignment, together with one to be handed over to the Owners or their representative, and I have to request that you will forward the usual application form, Request 9.

At the same time I have to point out that if the freeing port area is not made equal to the rule requirements, the freeboard regulations require the freeboard to be increased by the addition of one percent of the moulded depth, viz, $3\frac{1}{2}$ " in this case, making the freeboard 6'-3" instead of 5'-11 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", as conditionally assigned.
