

Sunderland Shipbuilding Co. S.S. No. 259.

The total weight of the three ^{stickless} bronze anchors supplied to this vessel is 60 lbs in excess of the Rule requirements.

In the case of the 1st bronze the head is 12 lbs (= $\frac{1}{2}\%$ light) but the weight of the anchor is 98 lbs in excess of the rule.

In the case of the second bronze the head is 39 lbs light, = about 2%, but the total weight of the anchor is 222 lbs in excess of the weight allowed by the Rules for the second bronze.

In these circumstances, as the anchors have already been supplied to the vessel, it is submitted they may be approved of in this instance provided the owners consent to the same be obtained, and the maker has informed that this case is not to be considered as a precedent and that the rule requirement for the weight of anchor heads being $\frac{3}{8}$ " the total weight of the anchor should be adhered to in all future cases.
