The E.W. repairs as above examined & found efficient.

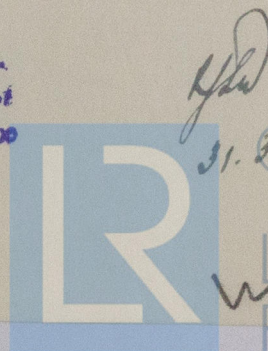
