on this date.

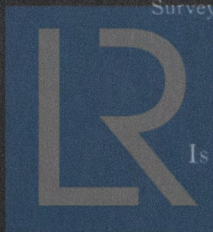
I have compared the arrangements on board the ship with those given in the original freeboard report and I have found them to be in agreement therewith or equivalent thereto, and the whole to be in efficient condition.

The special Survey N° 3 has been carried out in its entirety at this time and the record of Survey 6.37 with notation S.S. South Shields N° 3 - 6.37 recommended. The following repairs have been effected:-
35 hatch cleats and 90 latches (80 single & 10 double) renewed.
Hatch locking bars replaced throughout with new wire lashings.
1 Port light renewed.
3 Ventilators and one ventilator crowing tube renewed.
Pop store hatch rest bars renewed.
2 new tarpaulins supplied for bunker hatch.
9 Hatch beams renewed, and 3 repaired.

The freeboard marking has been verified and found to agree with the freeboards given on certificate No. *5000* dated *8th August 1933* which is returned herewith.
