Dear Sirs,

H. With reference to your letter of the 19th instant relative to the steamer "SHELDRAKE", I beg to inform you that the case has received consideration today. In reply I am directed to inform you that provided the vessel be submitted to a General Examination at an early date, and a satisfactory report as to her condition be received from the Society's Surveyors, or a reasonable part of the 2nd Special Survey No.1 be held, the Committee will be agreeable to the completion of the Special Survey in question being postponed until sometime within the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules, i.e., by the end of November, 1937. In the circumstances perhaps you will be so good as to let me know in due course what arrangements are proposed to be made for this matter to receive attention.

Your remarks regarding the Boiler Survey are also noted.
