In reply to the queries contained in your letter of the 30th ultimo regarding this vessel, I have to state that the sheerstrake is doubled at break of poop for a length of about 18 feet, shell brackets are fitted at bulkheads in lieu of doublings to outside strakes, bulk angle frames are carried to poop, bridge and forecastle decks alternately, the shell plating is foggled as stated in the report.

The ship forging report is forwarded herewith.
