Dear Sir,

With reference to the freeboard verification form in respect of the steamer "SHELDRAKE", I have to report as follows:-

- (1). The hatch cleats at Nos. 1 & 2 hatchways on the upper deck are ^{now} spaced not more than 24" apart, and battens provided for the bunker hatch fidley top.
- (2). All air pipes and ventilators are provided with efficient closing appliances, and ventilators efficiently stayed.
- (3). Closing appliances on casings, superstructures and companion have been made efficient.
- (4). See letter dated 3rd September, 1932.
