Dear Sir,

With reference to the attached freeboard verification in respect of the Sailing vessel "PONAPE", I have to report as follows:-

- (1). The bearing surface of covers of small hatchway under Forecastle has been increased to 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and two tarpaulins supplied.
- (2). Two tarpaulins have been supplied for small hatchway on poop and one tarpaulin and 2" wood cover for small hatchway in poop.

Efficient battening down arrangements have been provided.

- (3). The panelled wood doors closing the openings in poop bulkhead have been additionally stiffened by 1/8" steel plate backing.

The S.S. 3rd No.1 has been completed except for repair or replacement of one length of chain cable, which matter is to be attended to at Mariehamn.
