

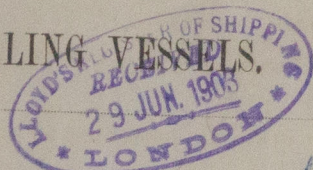

Centre of disc to top of statutory deck line 5 ft 3 ins.

Fresh water line above centre of disc 4 1/2 ins.

Winter North Atlantic line below centre of disc 3 ins.

Distance between the top of statutory deck line on vessel's side and the intersection of the continuation of upper side of wood deck with the vessel's side 1 3/4 ins.

NOTE.—It should be clearly shown whether the statutory deck line is set off from a wood or iron deck.
