With reference to your memorandum of the 8th April last, I shall be glad to learn whether this vessel is still laid up.

This vessel is still laid up. You will observe that your original letter has not been received yet.

Since the receipt of this confirmation, the Owners had a firm offer to sell the "Gardenga" for breaking up and were going to tow the vessel to the U.K. with their s/s "Endymion".

This arrangement fell through on account of limited time allowed off their present charter. I will advise any movement immediately. *WJG.*
