Negotiations are in hand for the sale of this vessel to Italian Owners, vide recent exchange of telegrams.

In view of the vessel's present class in the Register Book

"For coasting service Oran to Agadir and Valencia to Lisbon" the Italian buyers want to know if the present limitation can be altered to read

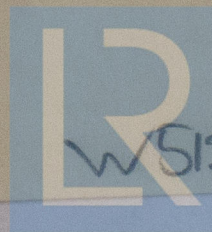
"for Mediterranean Coasting Service", or if this has to be limited, "Italian Coasting and Sardinia".

From what we know of the vessel's behaviour in the Atlantic, this would appear to be reasonable.

The boiler survey would be completed before changing ownership or resumption of the present Coasting Trade. The vessel is still laid up.
