Dear Sir,

Referring to your letter of the 15th instant regarding the report on the freeboards of the T.S.S. "GARDENGA", I beg to inform you that the moulded depth is 8.35 feet (2.55 m), and not 7.94 feet, as stated in the report. Please excuse the mistake made.

The length on the load waterline is 129.26 feet. No sheathing is laid on upper deck. There are five freeing ports on each side, the two aftermost ports having an opening of 700/320 mm. with a hinged door, the three others having an opening of 800/500 mm. secured by two rods of 3/4 inch diameter. No side scuttles are fitted.

As the case is urgent I cabled you to-day as follows:-

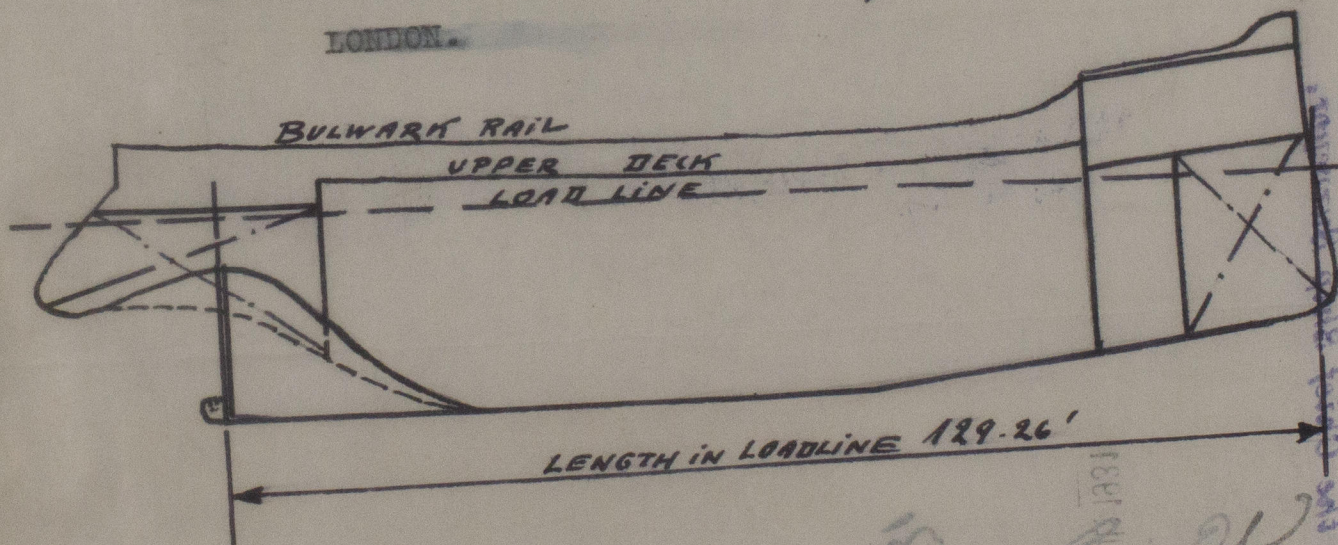

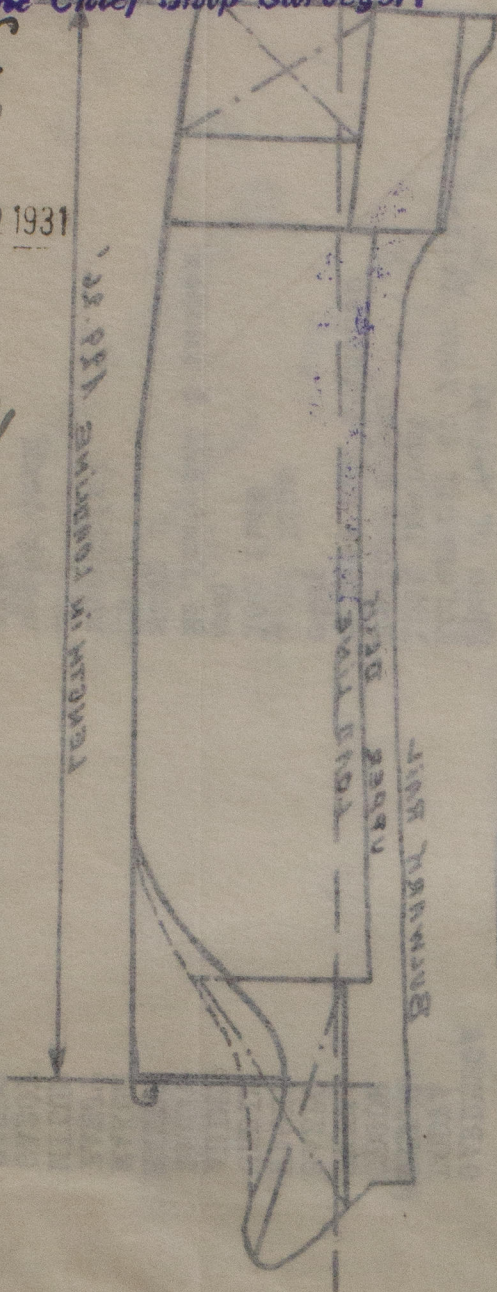
