M. With reference to your report on the freeboards of the T.S.S. "GARDENGA", I have to request that you will check the moulded depth given in the report as 7.94 feet, as the depth given on the approved midshipssection is 8.35 feet. You should also give the length on the load waterline, the thickness of the sheathing on the upper deck, full particulars of the freeing ports and the distance from the top of the keel to the lower edge of the lowest side scuttle, if scuttles are fitted.
