I am duly in receipt of your letter of the 23rd instant respecting the proposed classification of the s.s. "GARDENGA" and the information contained therein has been duly conveyed to Lieutenant Commander Wardrop.

It is noticed however that no reference is made to the proposals submitted with my second letter of the 20th instant as regards the protection of the shafting in lieu of the shaft tunnels which were required by you when the matter was discussed in London with Mr. Wardrop, and as Mr. Wardrop is very much interested to know as soon as possible whether the suggested arrangements can be approved by the Committee I shall be glad in the event of the matter not having been replied to in the meantime, if on receipt of this letter the question of the shaft tunnels could be looked into and, if practicable, a cablegram sent to this Office at your earliest convenience intimating the Committee's decision in this matter.

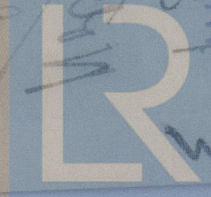
