Messrs. Douglas & Ramsey of Glasgow, on the 19th April 1937 visit the vessel "COLUMBIA" ex "BELGENLAND", No. 73373 in the Register Book, at present being broken up at Messrs. P. & W. MacLellan Ltd's Yard at Do'ness for the purpose of ascertaining to what extent vessel was demolished.

It was found on examination that the Twin Engines were demolished, five out of ten boilers cut up and scrapped, and the remainder partially dismantled.

Approximately 30% of the hull structure was cut away and in her present state she is quite unfit for navigation.

In my opinion, the work of demolition of this vessel has reduced her to such a condition as to render her reconstruction as a trading vessel an impracticable proposition.
