Dear Sirs,

With reference to the Convention freeboard certificate and certified copy forwarded to you on the 21st May 1932 in respect of the steamer "BELGENLAND", I have to acquaint you I am advised by the Board of Trade that this vessel now also holds a Safety Certificate, and that the Load Line Certificate should be endorsed as follows:-

"When more than 12 passengers are carried the freeboard of the ship shall be governed by the terms of the Passenger and Safety Certificate."

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will obtain the freeboard certificate and copy from the Owners and amend the passenger endorsements thereon to agree with the above, and initial the same.

You should advise this Office when the matter is in order.
