Gentlemen,

I am in receipt of Mr. Kendall's letter of the 15th instant with its enclosures respecting Messrs. Harland & Wolff's S.S. No. 391, and with regard thereto I have to inform you that provided the particulars and dimensions now supplied be verified on the completion of the vessel, a freeboard of 18'-5" for all seasons measured from the top of the statutory deck line $\frac{1}{2}$ " above the steel awning deck at side, corresponding to the desired draft of 31'-2" will be recommended to the Committee for approval.

It is noted that any sidelights which are less than six inches above the water line will be of the under water pattern, and it is understood these will be made to comply with the Board of Trade Circular No. 1485.

The plans forwarded for reference are returned herewith.
