dated 9 Dec 1913 to Belfast Surveyors.

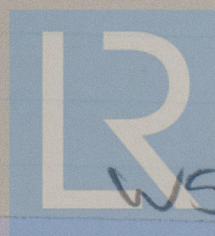

"We are instructed to hand the plans of the
latter vessel to you for your information and guidance
in the survey of the vessel and accordingly have
pleasure in enclosing them herewith, together with
a sheet giving the usual particulars of sheer &c, and
an application form for provisional assignment
of freeboard.

We may say that we wish to have a load draft
of an inch or two more than 31' - not more on
account of flotation.

Extract from Surveyors letter 15 Dec 1913

"It may be mentioned that any side lights
which are less than six inches above the water
line will be of the under water pattern.
