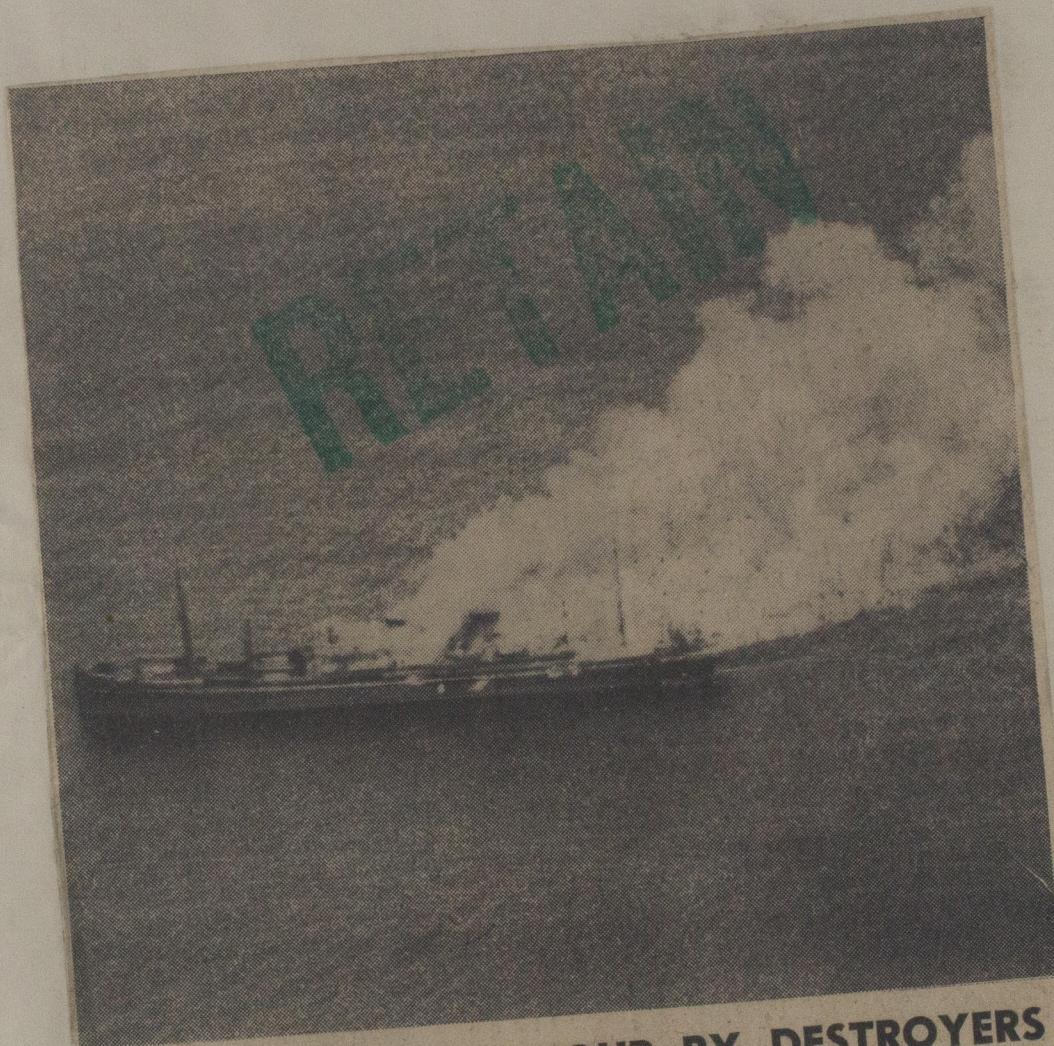

SHELLED FOR AN HOUR BY DESTROYERS

Spanish Government steamer Cabo Santo Tomé (12,589 tons), ablaze off Cape Rosa, Algeria, after an hour's bombardment by two unknown destroyers. Crew, numbering nearly 100, took to the boats. One of them was killed; six were wounded. French seaplanes hunted for the destroyers without success. Soon after this picture was taken the Cabo Santo Tomé—she had been bound for Spain from Russia—sank.
