Sté COMARIN, 29, rue de Marignan, Paris, for breaking up
purposes. This company, in turn, sold her to "Omnium Métallur-
-gique des Ferrailles & Métaux", 5, rue Cardinal Mercier, Paris
(9^e) for the same purpose.
