Mention was made in these columns on Tuesday that the sale of a London-owned steamer to shipbreakers was being negotiated. This transaction has now been completed, and the vessel in question, the *Clan Mackenzie*, has been sold to the West of Scotland Shipbreaking Company, Ltd., Glasgow. Owned by the Clan Line Steamers, Ltd. (Cayzer, Irvine & Co., Ltd., managers), London, the *Clan Mackenzie* was built in 1917, and has a gross and net tonnage of 6554 and 4120 respectively. She has been lying damaged at Liverpool following a collision some months ago.
